Cenotaph area.

The Council has recently completed the upgrading of the Cenotaph and the surrounding gardens. This has included re-surfacing the pathway, cleaning the Cenotaph stone and re-gilding the lettering, upgrading the lighting system and re-turfing some of the lawned areas.

Clean Neighbourhoods & Environment Act 2005

The Council would like to remind the residents of Freckleton that the Fouling of land, Dogs on lead and Dog exclusion Order 2009, in force on the Bush lane playing fields, is being abused.

Any person caught allowing their dog to violate this Order will be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice of £75.

All Weather Surface area at the Rawstorne Centre
