a) Police Update - To receive an update from Sgt Paul Glennon-Hill.

There have been instance of shop lifting which have been delt with.

The main problem in Freckleton currently is anti-social behavior that the police believe are as a result of drug taking and drug dealing. The Police have issued warrants.

Overall things in Freckleton are going reasonably well compared to other areas of the Fylde. The Police and Crime Commission have promised more resources but it can take up to 2 years to see new officers coming through.

A member of the public asked about the council taking over the maintenance of the Churchyard as it hadn't closed yet. The Clerk reported it may be up to 12 months before it closes. Freckleton Parish Council will report it to FBC when it closes and they will take over the maintenance of it 3 months later.
